It has been decided that the 2020 Specialty location in Mesquite, Texas will be **moved to 2022**.

For this year (**October 2020**) plans will be made to hold an abbreviated **BCOA National Specialty at Purina Farms in Gray Summit, MO** as an outdoor show, only to use indoors if needed for inclement weather. We are actively working on ironing out all of the details and will announce them as they unfold. As mentioned, this will be tentative, as we still need to watch the next couple of months how the pandemic evolves.

Code of Recommended Practices Committee Report

The BCOA Board appointed a Special Committee to update Basenji Club of America Recommended Code of Practices. See BCOA BOARD BALLOT 2016-09 APPROVED
SUBJECT: Code of Recommended Practices-Special Committee

The committee is in the final stages of bringing this Code of Ethics up to date to reflect current standards and practices. The proposed document is presented to the Membership for consideration and comment prior to finalization and ballot for approval later in the year. The comment period for the membership will end on Tuesday, July 10 2020.

Final proposal shall be presented to the Board and reviewed to ensure compliance to the directive, established policy, and the bylaws of BCOA. Upon Board approval, final proposal will be sent to the entire membership for approval. Given the significance of the Recommended Code of Practices, the Board will require a 2/3 vote of the membership to amend the current adopted Recommended Code of Practices. Passage shall constitute an affirmation of all members.

Basenji Club of America Recommended Code of Practices shall have a prominent place on the Club's web site and distributed to each new membership during the application process.

The comment period for the membership will end on Tuesday, July 10 2020.

The Committee will clarify what each member question/comment is, collect all comments received by June 30, 2020 and then discuss all comments with the board. Once all member questions/comments have been considered and a final revision is complete, the membership will be balloted for their approval during 2020.

We are working on a survey of the state of health of the breed, to include breeder/owner reports of diseases not recorded by OFA. We hope everyone will participate, results will be aggregate, no individuals identified. We are especially interested in emerging diseases, such as cystinuria. More information soon.

Quick Update of Hips, Fanconi, and PRA OFA Testing Results:

Hip Dysplasia

1 7 1	# Tested	Excellent	Good	Fair	Dysplastic (Mild-Severe)
1993	118	24%	68%	5%	5%
2019	100	27%	69%	3%	3%

Conclusion: Hip Dysplasia remains at a relatively low constant 3-5% in the breed. Neither better nor worse.

Fanconi Syndrome



2019	410	69%

Conclusion: Basenji breeders have made great strides in breeding away from Fanconi, although it should be noted that the number of dogs tested has declined precipitously, once most of the breeding stock was tested.

PRA (Progressive Retinal Atrophy

Tested % Normal 2013 (first year of testing) 460 74% 2019 244 76%

Conclusion: Breeders are not testing as much of their breeding stock for PRA as they are for Fanconi. PRA rates are essentially flat, neither better nor worse.

Their commitment serves as an inspiration to those who would, in turn, take the sport to greater heights. The 2019 Hall of Fame inductees include two remarkable individuals. Judith K Lange Basenjis of Amun



Judith Lange, kennel name "Amun Basenjis", was a decades-long advocate for the sport of lure coursing, and for ASFA in particular. She respected ASFA's structure and would remind people that ASFA is "a grass roots, by-the-people type organization". For 30 years Judy provided guidance and leadership in Region 1. Judy was the one to greet new people, make them feel welcome, and encourage them to be active with their hounds. For many Pacific Northwest coursing enthusiasts and Basenji owners under the age of 60, Judy was the first person in our sport that they remember meeting. She admired puppies, invited newcomers to club events, encouraged people to help on committees, and worked to keep people involved in the sport. Judy became a mentor and supportive friend to many over the years.

Judy was a member of the Evergreen Basenji Club (EBC). From the 1980s through 2019. She was almost always on the board and was usually an officer. Judy was EBC's Field Trial Secretary for many years, and coordinated the trials for many years as well. She hardly ever missed an EBC lure trial. She would also field clerk, organize inspection, train huntmasters, or otherwise do whatever needed to be done. (Judy was a founding member of the Twin Peaks Ibizan Club (TPIC) in the 1990s. She was instrumental in establishing and sustaining their lure coursing program.

Judy was also a member of the Basenji Club of America (BCOA). She served on the BCOA Lure Coursing Committee in the 2000s, where her collaboration and problem solving skills were greatly appreciated. She was the ASFA Region 1 Director in the early 2000s. Judy was instrumental in developing the Region 1 website (https://asfaregion1.com), which is an electronic gem that opened up communication among the Region 1 clubs, and provided a region-wide calendar and a centralized clearinghouse for information, including premium lists. Judy was also instrumental in putting Region 1 on Facebook.

Judy Lange, Amun Basenjis, of Kent Washington, passed away on June 4th, 2019, just days after Evergreen Basenji Club's May ASFA trial, where she had been helping new exhibitors as they fumbled with their slip leads. Judy's sudden passing was a shock to us all. The Evergreen Basenji Club is honored to nominate Judy to the ASFA Hall of Fame for her contributions to growth, strength, and collaboration within the
