Nominating Committee Information

Due to Secretary error the Nomination Process is about a month behind. Sorry for the error. Janet

The board will work to get things up to speed in June and have the Slate of Candidates for 2022 Officers and Board of Directors by the July 8 deadline. After that date the process should continue as described in the BCOA By-laws The complete process is noted here.

SECTION 5. NOMINATIONS. No person may be a candidate in a Club election who has not been nominated in accordance with these by-laws. A Nominating Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Directors before May 15 and the Secretary shall immediately notify the committeemen of their selection. The Committee shall consist of five Regular members from different areas of the United States, all members in good standing, no more than one of whom may be a member of the current Board of Directors. The Board shall name a Chairman for the Committee. The Nominating Committee may conduct its business by mail, telephone, or electronic message.

(a) On or before July 1, the Nominating Committee shall nominate from among the eligible members of the Club one candidate for each office and for each other position on the Board of Directors and shall procure their verbal or written acceptance. The Committee shall also obtain a resume of not more than 250 words of each nominee so chosen. The Committee shall consider geographic representation of the membership on the Board to the extent that it is practicable to do so. The Committee shall then submit its slate of candidates and their resumes to be received by the Secretary not later than July 8. The list, including the full name and state of residence of each candidate, shall be published in the BCOA Bulletin Board Newsletter on or before July 15, so that additional nominations may be made by members if they so desire.

(b) Additional nominations of eligible members may be made by written petition addressed to the Secretary and postmarked to his or her regular address prior to August 15. The Secretary must receive petitions not later than August 21, even if it is not a mail delivery day. The petitions must be signed by five members in good standing and accompanied by both the written acceptance of each additional nominee signifying his or her willingness to be a candidate and a resume of not more than 250 words of each additional nominee. No person shall be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from among those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee.

(c) If no valid additional nominations are received in accordance with Section 5 b above, the Nominating Committee's slate shall be declared elected on October 1 and no balloting will be required. The elected nominees' resumes shall be published in the November issue of the Club's Bulletin Board newsletter.

(d) If one or more valid additional nominations are received by the Secretary on or before August 21, the Secretary shall, on or before September 15, send to each member in good standing, a ballot as per Article IV, Section 3, listing all of the nominees for each position in alphabetical order, including their states of residence and with the nominees' resumes attached. The Inspectors of Election shall check the return ballots against the list provided by the Secretary of members whose dues are paid for the current year, and shall certify the eligibility of the voters as well as the results of the voting. The inspector shall notify the Secretary of all election results before October 30. The Secretary shall notify the membership of all election results in the November issue of the Club Bulletin Board newsletter or by mail not later than November 20.

(e) Nominations cannot be made at the annual meeting or in any manner other than as provided above.

In accordance with the Bylaws any member in good standing may send comments on applicants for membership to the BCOA Secretary within a period of fourteen days following the date of the newsletter publication. Comments will be sent to these person(s) for reply, and all comments and replies will then be sent to the Board.

News from the Health Committee - Chris Maxka

OFFA Basenji Survey is closed.

The **Basenji Health Survey** coordinated by the **Orthopedic Foundation for Animals** and the **BCOA Health Committee** is now closed. Thank you everyone who participated. The raw data may be seen at <https://www.ofa.org>. Select "About," "Health Surveys," and "Basenji." The data will be analyzed and reported, more information to follow.

A few years ago the **BASENJI HEALTH ENDOWMENT, INC** sponsored a study to map the chromosomes of **BASENJI GENOME**. A Research Article describing this project was recently published in **BMC Genomics**. Here is a link to article: [Chromosome-length genome assembly and structural variations of the primal Basenji dog \(Canis lupus familiaris\) genome](#)

This is a highly technical report of the sequencing of the Basenji genome. The researchers are demonstrating that using a primitive breed genome, like the Basenji, as a reference point for other breed comparisons, identifies more variants than a highly constructed breed such as the Boxer, who was the first breed to have a complete genome map.

Two Basenjies, a female, Aus Ch. Zanzipow Bowies China Girl and a male, Am Ch Kibushi the Oracle, provided the samples.

In addition to providing a representative basal breed genomic reference, this study generates "core genomic information for the Basenji that has the potential to inform future studies of population history and aid disease management." We breeders might hope it will be useful in identifying the mutation that leads to cystinuria, for example.

In Memory of Judith Holiday

In the early 1990's Russ and I were in Colorado; Russ was there to do apprentice judging for ASFA. At the trial we met Doc and Judith Holiday, who were with our good friend Evelyn Woolery. Evelyn lived in Kansas City at that time and we were all members of the Show-Me Basenji Club. Judith and Doc were strong supporters for the BCOA and ASFA Coursing. They never entered dogs in any of the events, but they were there to support other people, and, always, the Basenjjs.

In 1998 Judith was looking for another Basenji to replace her old Basenji. I had sold a puppy to an older couple in Colorado. Within a few months the wife died and he decided that he had to return the puppy. I called Judith and she immediately went and got the puppy. A month after she picked up Jezzy, her brother was returned to us by a family who decided they really didn't want a puppy. Well, Judith said she would take him too and off he went to Colorado. In 2002, Russ and I had a show puppy that was scared the first time in the ring and never got over the shock; he clearly did not have a show career, so once again Judith stepped in and took another Basenji from us. We had a strong bond in these shared dogs.

In retirement, Judith started House of Argyle to sell a variety of specialty items, many (but not all) of them BCOA or ASFA items. She had embroidered caps, shirts, coats, patches, pins and any number of other items, many relating to Basenjjs and other sighthounds.

Through the years I kept in touch with Judith, and often helped out at the Argyle booths at Specialties. Judith often sent me her items to sell and samples of her ideas and products.

When Judith could no longer run the business, she asked me to come to her home and take all of her inventory. Due to the pandemic this was not possible. When Judith died on the first of November, I arranged to get the dog-related items, with the help of Pat Bird and Laurie Stargell. Pat also arranged for a local ASFA club president to come and get the ASFA items for their club. Laurie then took all of the rest of the BCOA items to her house.

With so much inventory pertaining to the Basenji Club of America I decided that since Judith was so supportive of the National Club, I would donate all of the items that had Basenji themes to the Basenji Club of America, in her name. I think Judith would have wanted it that way. Please enjoy them...

(I want to thank Pat Bird, Laurie Stargel, Lynn Konken, and Dan Heidel especially for their help with this huge job. Others also helped along the way; a big thanks to them as well.

Vickie Jacobs, Cynosure Kennel

Janet Ketz asked me to add a few words about myself. Russ and I have owned Basenjjs since the early 1980s, when we got our first pet...that didn't really work out. We made all the mistakes we now warn puppy buyers about. We did a much better job with our next Basenji, which we wisely bought from Linda and Jerry Ehlers: Ricky was a multiple group winning special, with an LCM and a CDX to boot. (Actually, Russ reminds me that he had a Basenji as a teenager, back in the mid-60s, bought after he saw "Goodbye My Lady.")

Russ is a retired Chair of the Philosophy department at Washburn University. Over the early years, he trained our Basenjjs and later, Bouvier des Flandres, in obedience, tracking and lure coursing. While Russ did most of the performance events, and I did all of the conformation events. (Russ says he always got the naughty ones to show in the conformation ring!) Vickie is currently teaching Yang Style Tai Chi Chuan at Washburn University. She has also shown dogs professionally, and groomed a number of show dogs. Together, Russ and Vickie (Cynosure Kennels) have finished over 35 titles, including conformation, tracking, ASFA lure coursing, and barn hunt titles. Our next endeavor will be scent work.

Breaking News: CDC To Suspend Importation of Dogs from Countries Classified as High Risk for Rabies

Today, the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced the temporary suspension of the importation of dogs from countries classified as high risk for canine rabies. This suspension will also apply to dogs arriving from countries not considered a high risk if the dogs have been in a high-risk country during the previous six months. The new suspension applies to all dogs, including puppies, emotional support dogs, and dogs that traveled out of the United States and are returning from a high-risk country. CDC has coordinated with other federal agencies and entities as necessary to begin implementing this action, and will review the suspension periodically. The suspension is due to commence July 14, 2021.
