BCOA ByLaws SECTION 4. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP. Membership may be terminated:

(b) BY LAPSING. A membership will be considered lapsed if such member's dues remain unpaid on February 1 of each year. An automatic grace period until March 1 applies to all members, but if dues remain unpaid as of March 1, the membership will be terminated. Members who allow their memberships to lapse and to be terminated pursuant to this paragraph must reapply for membership pursuant to Article I, Section 3, of these By-Laws. In no case may a person be entitled to vote at any Club meeting whose dues are unpaid as of the date of the meeting.See the Reinstatement Application on the last page.

Opt-In Waiver for Electronic Balloting:

Per the AKC direction and the BCOA Bylaw: The Secretary will require members who choose Electronic Balloting to sign written authorization agreeing to use of the Electronic Balloting method, which the Secretary shall keep on file. The authorization is revocable by the Member with a 30 day advance written notice or by the Secretary and must state that the Member agrees to release the club from any liability should the ballot be received late or not received by the member due to circumstances beyond the club's control. Members who fail to provide a written authorization will continue to receive all materials via USPS mailed Paper Ballot. If Electronic Balloting is offered, the Secretary will keep two lists of members: one sent to the Electronic Balloting firm and the other for USPS mailed Paper Ballot.



Last week, House Bill 594 was introduced in Pennsylvania relative to COVID-19 limitations and restrictions as they may apply to a number of recreational activities, including dog shows and events. AKC wishes to clarify its position on this legislation.

Early on during the COVID-19 Pandemic, AKC worked to developed <u>guidelines</u> to assist those clubs who wish to hold events, and are able to do so safely, where allowed by state rules and local governments. AKC guidelines for the holding of dog shows require additional specific actions relative to safe canine exhibition and social distancing, as well as following all CDC, state and local guidance in effect at the time of the event.

AKC's position and its commitment to the health and safety of event exhibitors during the pandemic has not changed.

As introduced, Pennsylvania House Bill 594 does not reduce health and safety protocols for events, but rather states that *arbitrary restrictions should not be established specifically to prevent dog shows and similar animal events*. If events are being permitted, regulations should be uniformly applied across different types of events.

AKC thanks Representative Millard for his desire to see dog shows conducted safely in his district when appropriate, and requires who organize and participate in events to follow all protocols to ensure the safety of all involved.
