## **BCOA Health Committee Report**

### Chris Maxka, Chair

As Chair of the BCOA Health Committee, I recently "attended" the annual AKC Canine Health Foundation National Parent Club Canine Health Conference in which scientists and veterinaries presented their research funded by the Canine Health Foundation. This year the conference was online only.

The following represents my attempt to pull together my notes to share with you. Some of the research studies were breed specific, not relevant to Basenjis, but others contained general information for our breeders and owners. The following are my brief notes on topics of interest.

#### **Immunology and Allergies**

Two factors that have a broad impact on the immune system are diet and stress. A high quality diet supports a healthy gut and gut microbiome, which in turns supports the immune response. Increased stress, on the other hand, lowers immune response. One researcher discussed the benefits of colostrum in enhancing the immune system, including:

- -a better reaction to stress,
- -a better response to vaccine,
- -a longer lasting immunity,
- -a better antibody response
- -lower inflammation.

SF68 probiotic was also found to enhance vaccine response and immunity.

#### **Canine Atopic Dermatitis**

One not uncommon condition that appears to be immune system and allergy related is Canine Atopic Dermatitis. Although the Basenji is not a breed considered to be at increased risk for this condition, our dogs do get it.

Here's what to know: this condition is progressive, and it usually persists for life. 10% of affected dogs experience onset by 6 months, 37% by 1 year, and 75% of cases appear by 3 years. Symptoms start with an itch, which progresses around paws, groin, and face, and may include ear infections. Additional allergies may develop over time, and if your dog has this condition, treatment should never stop.

This researcher was cautious in advising antibiotics however. She found that topical therapy (creams, etc) was successful 70% of the time, and recommends trying topicals before turning to antibiotics.

#### **Canine Epilepsy and CBD**

I'm sure there are some of you are interested in this topic: "Is CBD the Cure for Canine Epilepsy?" This was a very small, limited study, and although the initial findings were positive, it ended with the opinion that "more research is needed." Epilepsy is the most common neurological condition in dogs, and it was inevitable someone would look into the effectiveness of CBD in moderating this disease. Many dogs continue to have seizures even after being treated with anti seizure drugs, and CBD is an alternative therapy touted in humans. The study was preliminary, concluding the CBD appeared "well tolerated," although the researcher admitted she did not determine either the effectiveness nor the correct dosage.


The **AKC** is pleased to announce that an **enhanced DNA test kit** will become available July 2021, utilizing a new and improved way of submitting your canine DNA samples to AKC.

Submitting DNA samples is now simpler than ever. The new AKC DNA kits contain a barcode and an activation code, which customers will enter along with their contact and dog information via an online portal (<a href="www.dna.akc.org">www.dna.akc.org</a>). No more pen and ink paper forms are required and customers will mail their DNA samples directly to AKC's lab in Lincoln, NE, greatly improving processing turnaround time.

Also, customers will now automatically receive email notifications of sample status, eliminating guesswork and letting customers know the status of their sample as soon as possible. Results and DNA certificates ordered will still be mailed directly to the customer when processing of the sample is complete.

The current non-barcoded AKC DNA test kits (both prepaid and regular \$50 kits) will be phased out in July 2021. Any AKC DNA kits purchased prior to the barcoded kit update will still be accepted for processing. The original procedure of mailing the sample, payment and completed forms directly to AKC DNA Operations will still be required for processing these old-style, non-barcoded kits.
