Information for submitting an Additional Nomination for the 2023 Officers and Board of Directors:

From the BCOA Bylaws
Article IV
Section 5 Nominations

(a) On or before July 1, the Nominating Committee shall nominate from among the eligible members of the Club one candidate for each office and for each other position on the Board of Directors and shall procure their verbal or written acceptance. The Committee shall also obtain a resume of not more than 250 words of each nominee so chosen. The Committee shall consider geographic representation of the membership on the Board to the extent that it is practicable to do so. The Committee shall then submit its slate of candidates and their resumes to be received by the Secretary not later than July 8. The list, including the full name and state of residence of each candidate, **shall be published in the BCOA Bulletin Board Newsletter on or before July 15, so that additional nominations may be made by members if they so desire.**

(b) Additional nominations of eligible members may be made by written petition addressed to the Secretary and **postmarked to his or her regular address prior to August 15 September 17. The Secretary must receive petitions not later than August 24 September 24, even if it is not a mail delivery day.** The petitions must be signed by five members in good standing and accompanied by both the written acceptance of each additional nominee signifying his or her willingness to be a candidate and a resume of not more than 250 words of each additional nominee. No person shall be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from among those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee.

(c) If no valid additional nominations are received in accordance with Section 5 b above, the Nominating Committee's slate shall be declared elected on October 1 and no balloting will be required. The elected nominees' resumes shall be published in the November issue of the Club's Bulletin Board newsletter.

(d) If one or more valid additional nominations are received by the Secretary **on or before August 24 September 24**, the Secretary shall, **on or before September 15 October 1**, send to each member in good standing, a ballot as per Article IV, Section 3, listing all of the nominees for each position in alphabetical order, including their states of residence and with the nominees' resumes attached. The Inspectors of Election shall check the return

Per BCOA Ballot 2004-48, published in January 2005 Bulletin Board:

BCOA 2022 NATIONAL SPECIAL FEATURE EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION:

Getting One Paw Up on Pregnancy:

Management of the Bitch Prior to, During, and After Breeding to Optimize Outcome

Thursday afternoon, October 13, 2022

Guest lecturer: Dawna Voelkl, DVM, DACT

Adjunct Associate Teaching Professor, Theriogenology,*
College of Veterinary Medicine, University of Missouri

*Theriogenology is the study of animal reproduction

Dr. Voelkl's presentation will focus on management methods to optimize a bitch's probability of becoming pregnant, conceiving and maintaining a litter of normal size, and whelping successfully. Pre-breeding phenotypic and genotypic screening as well as endocrine and infectious disease testing will be reviewed. The impact and treatment of endocrine disorders such as hypothyroidism, luteal insufficiency, and hypocalcemia will be discussed. Recommendations regarding pre- and post-breeding nutrition and supplementation will also be offered.

Dr. Voelkl invites a "potpourri" of questions from the audience.

A portion of the seminar time will be allotted for pre-submitted questions and topics of particular interest to Basenji breeders. Thank you Janet for my introduction in the last Bulletin. I'm very excited to take this on, so first off, I would like to thank our Board of Directors for appointing me into this position.

As many of you know, I have taken up an active role in local legislation (animal and otherwise). This can be a daunting task but I urge every one of you to please keep your eyes open and pay attention to local and state legislation.

In a future Bulletin I will outline what YOU can do to stay informed, and what you can do to ACT effectively. Keep in mind that while we are focusing 100% of our "dog" time on training/grooming/breeding/traveling...the AR activists are pouring 100% of their energy into shutting down every activity related to animals. They want to stop everything from dog, horse, and, cat shows to hunting, farming and they are even writing legislation to make artificial insemination a state (and soon Federal) CRIME as "animal sexual assault". And believe me, they are gaining ground quickly and since they are always front and center with state representatives, they are being listened to and taken seriously.

This is an important election year, so no matter how busy you are, put aside a few extra minutes to make a connection with one or more of your representatives, city, county, state or federal and candidates running for office. You can do it by phone, email or letter. If you're not currently involved in legislation, simply introduce yourself as a constituent and as someone who loves dogs and has years of expertise to share if anything related to dogs comes up. If you don't know who represents you or how to contact them, go here to locate your state and federal representatives <https://www.naiatrust.org/find-your-elected-officials/> and for local representatives, Google city or county government. You don't need to write a long letter, just a simple paragraph will start the conversation. If there's a candidate you want to support, call their campaign headquarters and offer to help.

What do WE need to do? Take action. Start making phone calls and writing letters and attending meetings. And yes, even showing up at your local City Council meeting can make an impact. A brief and polite phone call to your Senator or State Representative helps. Call or email those running for local and state offices. Introduce yourself, what you do, WHY you do it, and how we as ethical dog breeders and enthusiasts are NOT the enemy, and in fact, we can SOLVE the issue of rescue and animal abuse.

I encourage all of you, if you have not already, to please visit NAIAonline.org and sign up (top right) to receive their informative newsletter. NAIA (National Animal Interest Alliance) is dedicated to REAL animal rights and our rights as owners/breeders/hunters/farmers.

Also, please visit senate.gov and locate your Senator, and DO call or write to him/her. Trust me when I say that the AR groups do often, and they have said they rarely (if at all) hear from us. Please, if you want our sport to survive, you must take action. **Please reach out to me with questions you might have about legislation, or to find out how you can get involved.**
