



All names submitted will be compiled and presented to membership for Stage 2. Candidates do not need to be submitted more than once to make the Stage 2 list.

Deadline for Stage I voting is February 25, 2023

You may nominate up to FIVE Judges in each category.

Please VERIFY that your candidate is eligible to judge Basenjis if nominating a CONFORMATION Judge candidate. Additionally, non-approved individuals may be approved by AKC to judge specialties on a case-by-case basis pending review of their knowledge and success breeding / exhibiting Basenjis for 15 years or more. You may nominate such a candidate in Stage 1.
