

Per BCOA Ballot 2004–48, published in January 2005 Bulletin Board:

WE DID IT! Patti Strand of NAIA and I set out, for a SECOND time, to defeat this Oregon House Bill 2915 that aims to prohibit "retail" sales of dogs in Oregon. This bill is vague and does not define "retail sales" (which could easily loop anyone selling a puppy), and has been backed both times by AR groups. Thanks to the overwhelming support of Oregon dog folks writing letters and making phone calls, this bill has been defeated a 2nd time.

while Patti and I feel very strongly against pet shops selling puppies, there are only 4 stores in Oregon who do this (2 of which will be soon discontinuing such sales for personal reasons), these sales represent less than 1% of all puppy sales in the state of Oregon. It is an unfair bill that does nothing but put us preservation breeders at risk and elevate sales of dogs at shelters. This bill does nothing to help reduce homeless pet population.

This is yet another huge win for Oregon dog fanciers, and proof that when we all lock arms and write letters, and make those calls, that we ARE heard. So please, ACT NOW to maintain your rights to show, breed, and enjoy the freedom of our wonderful purebred dogs. Please reach out to me to see what you can do to help in your state. The future of our sport is in great jeopardy. Well all must be activists.
